

TRAVEL TO OXFORD

Oxford is about 60 miles (90 km) north-west of London.

Accommodation, meals and registration will be in New College, Oxford University, located in the centre of the City.

Lectures will be held in the Inorganic Chemistry Laboratory, Oxford University, which is a five-minute walk from New College.

Please note that New College is open 24 hours, but after 11pm the gates are locked and you need to ring the doorbell for the porters to let you in.

From Heathrow Airport: Use the Oxford Bus Company X70 bus service to Oxford (Gloucester Green). Gloucester Green bus station is 10 minutes walk from New College. See <http://www.oxfordbus.co.uk/heathrow.html> for details.

From Gatwick Airport: Use the Oxford Bus Company X80 bus service to Oxford (Gloucester Green). Gloucester Green bus station is 10 minutes walk from New College. See <http://www.oxfordbus.co.uk/gatwick.html> for details.

From Stansted Airport: Use the National Express 757 bus service to Oxford (Gloucester Green). Gloucester Green bus station is 10 minutes walk from New College. See <http://www.nationalexpress.com/> and <http://www.nationalexpress.com/pdf/757.pdf> for details.

From London: Frequent 24-hour direct *bus services* connect Oxford with London. The Oxford Express service (<http://www.oxfordbus.co.uk/espress1.shtml>) includes Victoria Coach Station, Grosvenor Gardens, Marble Arch, Baker Street/Gloucester Place and Hillingdon. The Oxford Tube service (<http://www.oxfordtube.com>) includes Grosvenor Gardens, Marble Arch, Notting Hill Gate, Shepherd's Bush, and Hillingdon. The Gloucester Green bus station is 5 minutes walk from St John's College.

A frequent direct *train service* operates between Oxford and London Paddington. See <http://ojp.nationalrail.co.uk/planmyjourney> for details. Oxford rail station is about 15 minutes walk from New College. Or take a taxi.
